We have had reports this month of burglaries at dwellings where offenders have made entry to houses overnight, stolen keys and taken high-end cars from driveways. We are asking people to consider extra security and recommend CCTV. For a small outlay you can have a discrete wi-fi camera protecting your home. Alternatively installation of PIR lighting on driveways and at the side and rear of houses can give reassurance and act as a deterrent. We regularly get told after the event that people have had prowlers in the rear gardens of houses. We would ask that we get some notification of such events, preferably whilst it is happening. This information can be useful if only for intelligence purposes.

Numerous high footfall locations are reporting parking and obstruction problems, a knock-on effect from lockdown. In particular we are aware of Bosworth Waterpark, Thornton reservoir and Bosworth Park. We are able to enforce any unnecessary obstruction caused by parking, circumstances that will be assessed on an individual basis. The local authority are responsible for enforcement for any "line" offences and Leicestershire Highways for any new road improvement or line installation.

With heavy involvement from one of the local farms, a quantity of farming GPS equipment amounting to around 100k was recovered the same day as its theft. With self-initiative from the farm, and use of freely available modern technology was fitted to property allowing for the stolen property to be returned to its rightful owner. It goes to show that by thinking outside the box, preservation and retention of high value items can be achieved using modern day technology at a very reasonable cost.
