

October Priorities.

Burglaries & Vehicle Crime: In September, there has been an increase of burglaries and vehicle crime in particular in Quorn, Woodhouse and Rothley. We are putting more patrols across Charnwood West and conducting Stop Searches as necessary.

Anti-Social Behaviour: There has been several reports of youths taking part in anti-social behaviour in the village parks, in particular Stafford Orchard Park, Quorn and Woodhouse Eaves park off Main Street. Youths are being identified, engaged with and dealt with via the incremental approach.

Catalytic Converter Thefts: There has been an increase in catalytic converter thefts across Quorn, Cropston and Newtown Linford. We will be putting in more patrols across Charnwood West.

Crime Update and Crime Prevention Advice.

Across the beat we have seen a spike in the number of residential burglaries. These have mostly been forced entries via ground floor windows/patio doors and keys and vehicles stolen.

1. Laminated glass or security film is recommended for ground floor and accessible windows.
2. Sash stops prevent anyone opening the sash window enough to climb through.
3. Secure your bike to the ground or a lockable stand within a garage.
4. Security light; install an outside security light so that intruders can't approach without being seen.
5. Keep keys safe. Keep your keys out view when at home, and away from your front/back door. When not in use, keep your electronic car key in a security pouch to prevent it being scanned by thieves to open and steal your car nearby.
6. Fitting a solid secure steering wheel, gear leaver or clutch pedal security device can give your vehicle added protection.

Catalytic Converter Thefts.

The precious metal in catalytic converters has led to an increase in their theft. To keep yours safe, ask your car dealer if they can give you any advice on locks of guards that are approved by the vehicle manufacturer.

Alternatively, try to make sure your vehicle is parked in a garage overnight. If this isn't possible, park in an area that's well-lit and overlooked and try to park so that the converter can't be easily reached by potential thieves. Vehicles that sit high above the road are particularly vulnerable.

You should also register your converter and mark it with a forensic marker, which will make it harder for thieves to dispose of.
