We were successful this month in being able to grant drug warrants from the court Magistrates about houses we believe are dealing drugs in the local area. We conducted one at High Street and the other at Alexander Avenue. There were drugs located at the warrants and the suspects were dealt with for those offences. We would continue to encourage people to report this to us.

We have been dealing with extra Covid patrols and incidents since the stricter restrictions came into place with the rule of 6. We are visiting our licence premises more regular than usual in order to support and advise those visiting and we would encourage anyone attending the pubs to help support those local business' by abiding by the rules.

Barwell

We have been dealing with a lot of complaints of ASB within Byron Street, Barwell and have been working closely with partnership agencies at taking appropriate action against any perpetrators.

Since Covid 19 closed a lot of our premises down, we are pleased to be working more again at the George Ward Community Centre. There is lots of good work being done at the centre to make Barwell a better place and would encourage local residents to look at what facilities and inputs that occur there. It was only last week we helped a vulnerable female who came in to ask for help and we were able to complete a referral with her a secure her a place at a supported living accommodation as she had nowhere to live and had eaten so she was able to get a food bank voucher. Please do not be embarrassed to come and ask for help when it's needed, the community centre is happy to support anyone.

ASB at Hurst Road, Earl Shilton

What we did:

We have been trying to work with the young people that do gather in the local parks that can cause a nuisance to local residents living nearby. The young people were gathering in the alleyway at Norton Road, Barwell and we gave them restrictions not to attend this location but this meant they have then moved to a new park. There are allegations of drug use, noise nuisance and generally being rowdy and rude to local residents. We have been issuing warning letters, and looking at Anti-social behaviour contracts for those who require one.
