While there was a few tickets issued throughout lockdown we didn't receive any covid breaches for a good few months leading up to the restrictions ending.



Intelligence (Intel)

What is intelligence?

Intelligence is information that you the public give us in relation to crime and illegal activity. We use and produce intelligence at strategic, tactical and operational levels.

Looking to the future

After reporting intelligence to us, you may be wondering what the next steps are and if you will hear back from us. In order to protect your identity and the individuals involved, we tend to avoid contact.

However, if we urgently need further information or believe you or others involved may be at risk, we will consider contacting you.

The steps following an intelligence report are as follows:

Intelligence Report is received. This would usually be via our online reporting services, however this could also be via officers and staff on duty or by telephoning 101.

The information would then be assessed by a trained Intelligence officer. This involves researching the people, location, vehicles involved etc. but also opportunities of threat, risk or harm to the people involved.

The information would then be linked to relevant cases, investigations and people.

The intelligence officers will then look at opportunities to develop the intelligence further or take action, if it is required.
